The Proximity Collective name implies that we are proximate to several neighborhoods around our church where many of the residents live in poverty. The word collective embodies the idea of collecting different perspectives and strategies and resources and awareness as we ask the Lord about our role. We will follow the seasonal rhythms of Village Church with optional engagement opportunities for the congregation throughout the Liturgical Year.
